Western Plains Wind Farm

Epuron, a leading Australian-owned renewable energy company, is developing the Western Plains Wind Farm on the windy headland 4 kilometres north-west of Stanley in Tasmania. The project which will have up to 13



wind turbines will connect to the nearby Port Latta substation to supply renewable power to the National Electricity Market (NEM).

We have undertaken a range of studies including:

- Flora and fauna
- Avifauna
- European heritage
- Aboriginal heritage
- Landscape and Visual
- Traffic and transport
- Noise

We have also consulted widely with key agencies, individuals and the wider community.

Before lodging the Development Proposal and Environmental Management Plan (DPEMP) Epuron seeks the community's feedback on the proposed layout of the wind farm.

When we have had community input into the wind farm proposal we will finalise the design and lodge the application with Circular Head Council and the EPA.





- 1. Early design and grid studies
- **2.** Detailed investigations and preparation of DPEMP
- **3.** Information session to discuss the project with the full community
- **4.** Finalise design, submit and exhibit DA and DPEMP for public feedback
- **5.** Epuron to respond to feedback and modify proposal
- **6.** Council, EPA and Commonwealth final assessment
